"Walking The Flight Line" SAFETY INFORMATION

LOOKING AT AIRCRAFT IS FUN & ENJOYABLE, BUT WE NEED TO ENSURE WE REMAIN SAFE AS WELL

- Never touch a parked aircraft, especially the propeller, which should be considered "live". This means it may start just by moving it slightly!
- Aircraft are strongly constructed yet certain aspects of them can be quite delicate. Pushing or pulling on parts of an aircraft can damage them and place lives at risk.
- When walking around parked aircraft look out for tie down ropes and stakes which present a trip hazard.
- Watch out for edges of wings and ailerons as they are often at head height and leave a nasty bruise or cut if you head butt them inadvertently.
- If you have questions, find a pilot to ask, they love talking about their aircraft.

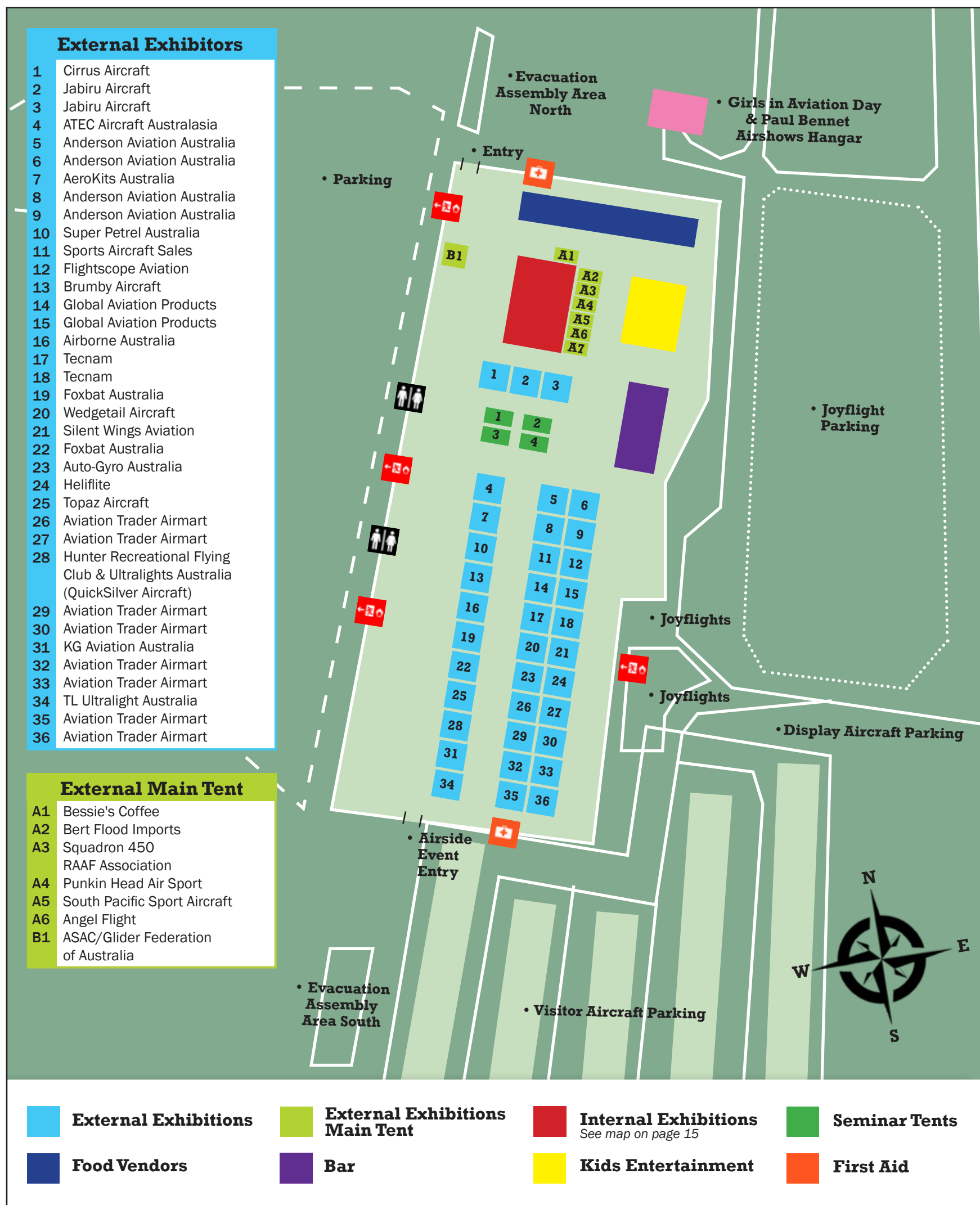

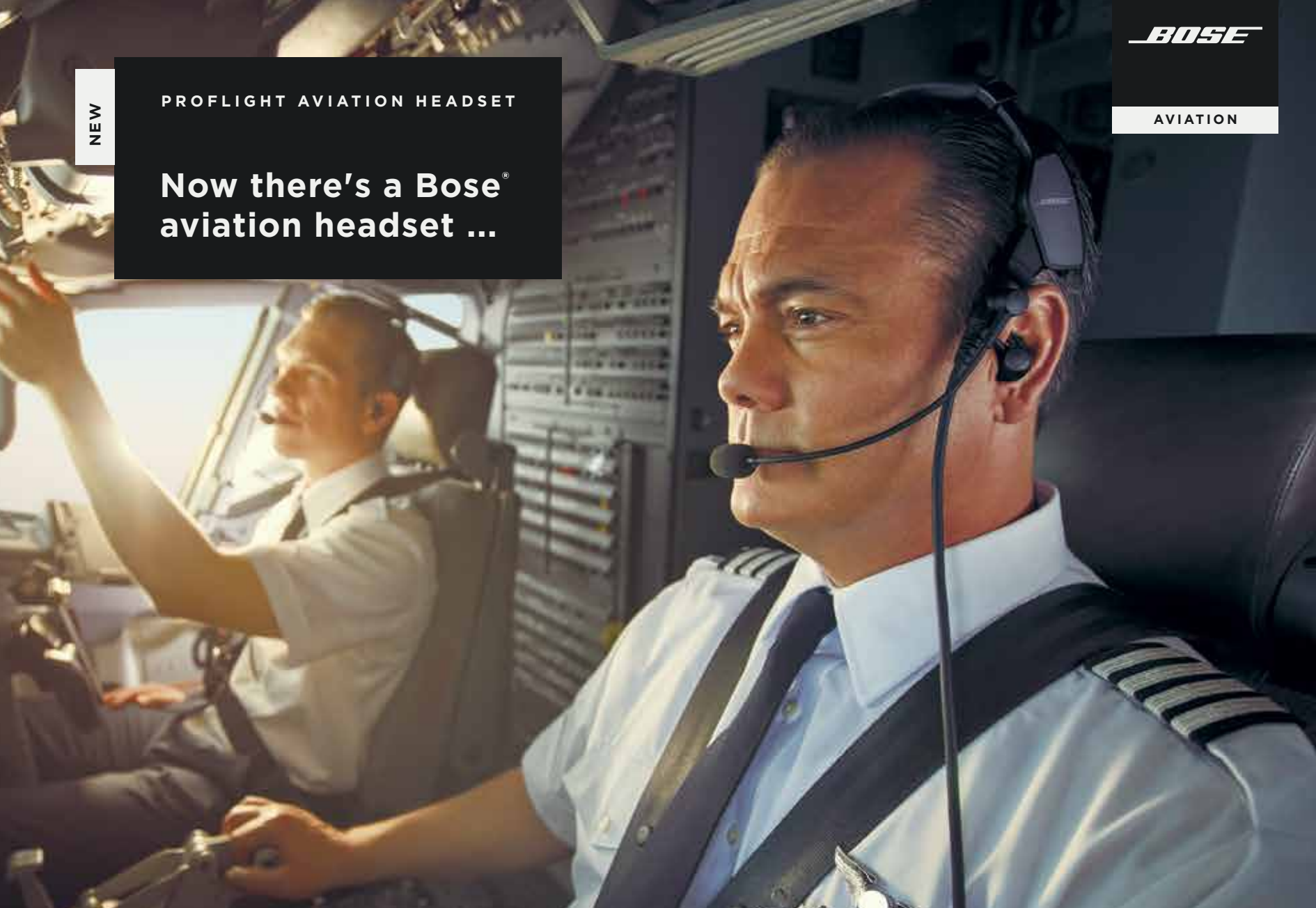
